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What is the Hillenbrandt Scholarship?

The Hillenbrandt Scholarship was established through a bequest that the Hillenbrandt Family left to the church in 2001. It was designed to be open to members of Good Shepherd who are pursuing a post-secondary education and are matriculated in any post-secondary program either part-time or full-time. The Hillenbrandt Scholarship is not need based, and persons may apply and reapply yearly for the duration of their education. A maximum of \$250.00 is awarded to each recipient each year, and the number of scholarships awarded depends on the merit of the individuals applying. Deadlines and Important Dates:

- The deadline for mailing the application to be considered for the upcoming school year, which includes fall and spring terms, is April 1st.
- The Hillenbrandt Scholarship is awarded on Trinity Sunday during the church service, with a fellowship hour following.
- In the fall of the year, upon verification of enrollment, the scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient to be used for school-related expenses.

Upon Completion of Application:

- Do not submit your application until you have all the required material.
- Make sure your application is typed or completed in ink.
- Sign and date your application where instructed.
- Seal your application in an envelope.
